- **Windows 7 Compatibility**
Software and hardware have been tested as functional in Windows 7.
- **Magnetic Stripe Reader to Read Patron Cards**
Allows patrons to use magnetic patron cards to log in to the system.
- **Upgraded Installation Wizard for the Client**
Installs prerequisites like MSMQ, .net Framework. Also installs the IEAK which allows any user to run CircIT. This also installs the most common pieces of hardware used and in a little over 8 minutes.
- **Web Service for Terminal Settings**
Terminal settings have now moved to the server for better management of all the client machines.
- **CircIT Staff Station Software**
Copies the information on a desktop antenna to the clipboard or the keyboard buffer, while running in the background. This can be done while running in a security on or security off mode, triggering the security of an item to get changed without additional input.
- **Check-In Receipts and Self Check-In**
Allows all users, including staff and patrons to print a check-in receipt for items that have successfully checked-in. We now also have the capability to allow the user to select from a check-out or check-in process if so desired.
