November 2008: FEDLINK Awards Northern Micrographics Reformatting Contract for the Fort Huachuca Museum The Federal Library and Information Network (FEDLINK) has awarded a contract to Northern Micrographics to provide reformatting services to the Fort Huachuca Museum in Ft. Huachuca, Arizona.

In the museum's continuing effort to provide research materials, the 1954 through 2002 issues of *The Ft. Huachuca Scout*, the command's weekly newspaper will be digitized. The source material, both 35mm roll film and aperture cards, will be scanned as grayscale images. Output will consist of archival TIFF images and searchable PDF files for access. In addition, the aperture cards will be converted to 35mm roll film with the output consisting of a master negative, print master and service copy.
