

# MONTEL AWARDED THE NEW VA MEDICAL CENTER PHASE IV HIGH-DENSITY MOBILE STORAGE SOLUTIONS CONTRACT

The center will provide complete medical services, including ambulatory care, radiology, laboratories, a pharmacy, diagnostic and treatment clinics, and educational facilities.

For this new state-of-the-art medical campus, Montel's scope in the project will involve the supply and installation of WIRED™ high-density powered storage systems, Mobilex mechanical storage systems, SmartShelf hybrid 4-Post shelving, and Aetnastak cantilever library shelving systems.
